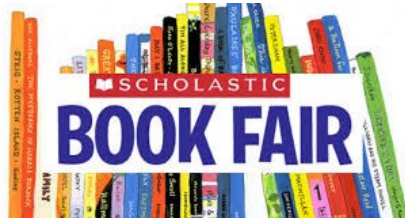


Exploring Christianity
