School Admission Statement

Nursery Education

St Michael's CE (VC) First School operates a Governor led nursery. Children can join Saint Michael's Nursery from the day after their third birthday. Prior to a child starting nursery they are invited with their parent to attend a stay and play sessions within the setting, a home visit from a nursery staff member is also arranged whenever possible. There are no set admission dates but parents/carers must complete a nursery contract before the child takes up their place. The school reserves the right to withdraw or refuse a nursery place for a child if a child's behaviour or needs cannot be met by the setting, no places are available or nursery fees are unpaid (see charging and remissions policy for further information)

The maximum number of children for the Nursery session is 33.

Primary Education

Children join the Reception class Saint Michael's School in September before their fifth birthday. Allocations are made by the Local Authority in line with their Admissions Policy. Current admission numbers for the school are 60 children in our two Reception classes.

Please note that an induction evening takes place prior to your child starting school. Induction to School for New Reception and Nursery Children
