We are currently working on assessments of phonics and reading and will send out spellings shortly as we want to give each child individual words this half term in relation to their assessment results.

If your child is off ill we will be putting some activities on Seesaw to help them with their learning especially if they are awaiting test results as this can take some time.



We look forward to working with you and your children throughout the year.

Topics for this Term



In English this term, we will be exploring fiction texts through “Superworm”, the ‘Enormous Turnip’ and stories from the past. We will explore non-fiction texts as part of our History topic ‘Old and New Toys’ and our science topics of ‘The Body’ and ‘Celebrations’. The children will work on punctuation and sentence structure, as well as descriptive writing, poetry and dictionary work.

In Mathematics this term the focus is on number, such as number bonds, place value, addition and subtraction. Please can children continue to learn and reinforce the number bonds within ten and twenty, for example two numbers that add together to make a number within twenty and the corresponding subtraction fact. i.e. $7 + 6 = 13$, $6 + 7 = 13$, $13 - 6 = 7$, $13 - 7 = 6$.

As part of our Science units we will be looking at ‘My Body’ and exploring ‘Light, Music and Food’ through Celebrations. We are looking forward to completing a number of exciting experiments to inspire the children to think like real scientists!

In Religious Education, we are looking at ‘Families and Celebrations’ through stories, symbols and visual expression.

In Physical Education they will be participating in skipping lessons and skipping based games.
