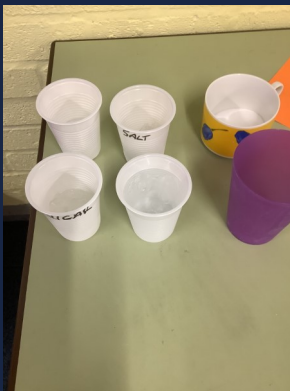


Early Years

Year 2

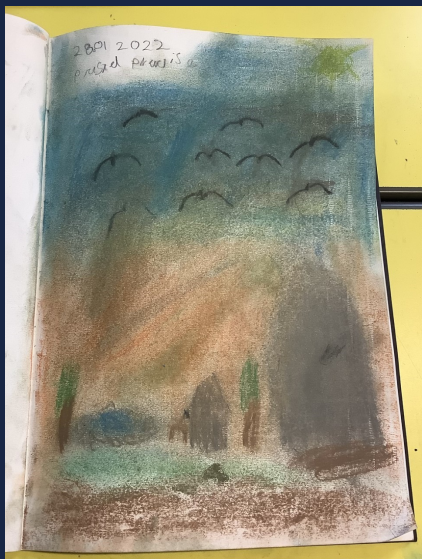


This week we have made fairy doors and gardens in the woods as we have been learning about writing fairy tales.



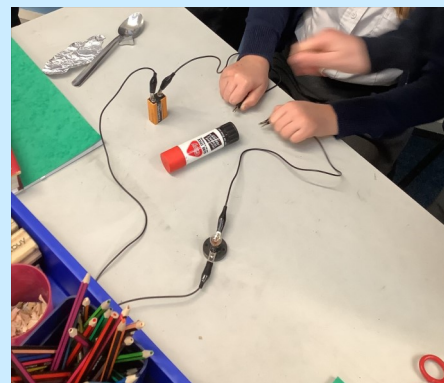
Year 3
