Reverend Ian is a regular visitor to the school leading worship, supporting with RE lessons and special days during the school year. He regularly welcomes the children to the church to support the RE lessons of different year groups for example leading a mock baptism service. As a school we also attend Open Door events at St Michael's for children in Years 1 and 3 these are led by school staff and the church community.

A number of volunteers from St Michael's Church help lead our after school 'Adventurers club.' Our Christian club focusses on stories from the bible through art, drama and craft. The sessions conclude with a short family worship to which the children's parents are invited to attend and in which the children play an active role sharing their learning from the session. This club is very well attended by children from Early Years through to Year 4.
