Learning in Year 2:

The attached page outlines some of the learning that will be taking place in our classroom this term. Please help support your child by talking to them about what they have been learning in school. Your child will need:

Please ensure that your child brings their reading book and diary to school every day. In school your child will be heard read as part of a guided reading session each week with the class teacher. Every child has already received their new spellings for this half term and we would like you to continue to practise these with your child at home.

The children will need their PE kit in a bag on their peg for a **Monday** indoor PE session and need to come to school in their outdoor PE kit on a **Wednesday**. Please remember if your child has long hair, it needs to be tied up and earrings must be removed for our PE lessons (tape is no longer allowed).

Our Topics for this Term are 'Significant people and events in our own locality' and 'Human and Physical Features of the coast and Stone'.



Our Topic work for this term is based on 'Significant people and events in our own locality like Josiah Wedgwood', 'The Human and Physical Features of the coast and Stone' for Geography and 'Living Things and Habitats' in science.

In English this term, we will be exploring both fiction and non-fiction texts linked to our 'Science Topic'. The children will work on punctuation and sentence structure, as well as narrative text and non-chronological reports. We will also be continuing our work on spelling and grammar.

In Mathematics this term we will be covering fractions, length and height, position and direction, time, mass, capacity and temperature. We will also continue to practise the 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables.

In Religious Education, we are looking at 'Sacred Texts eg Islam and the Qur'an' and 'Story Telling through sacred writing with a Gospel focus.'

In Physical Education, the children will be covering a range of team skills, racket and ball skills and dance lessons.
