Lego STEM Project

This term, children will be completing a project using Lego and coding on the IPad. This will involve them developing their teamwork skills to produce a group outcome. At the end of the project we will invite you into school to allow the children to share their work with you. Further information about this will follow.

Topic

As part of our Topic lessons, children will be exploring Map work, including using a four-figure grid reference and the use of a compass.

Please endeavour to listen to you child read on a daily basis when possible, and record this in their diary. Conversation around the book is vital in order to progress their understanding of a variety of genres and texts.















We ask that children practise their spellings at home and continue to practise their times tables. In Year 3, children need to recall their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables up to 12 x.
