Children will need to come into school in a black/navy jogging suit, white round necked t-shirt and trainers on a Tuesday.

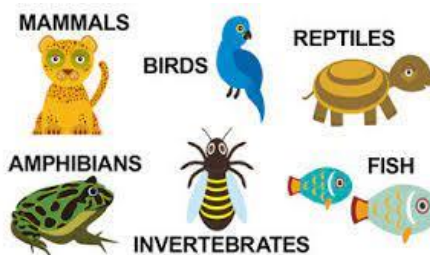
Supporting your child at home:

Our Topic for this Half Term is “Where in the world.”



In English we will be reading Handa’s Surprise and either The Ugly Five or We’re Going on a Lion Hunt and using the structure of these stories to write our own version.

In Mathematics we will be learning about fractions, multiplication, division, place value and money.
