The challenge:

You can take videos or photos to send into school at **sciencefair@st-michaels-stone.staffs.sch.uk** or you can bring your experiment to school. The deadline for science projects is Monday 13th March, leaving the remainder of the week a chance for myself Mrs Farrell and Mrs Cooper our Science Link Governor to judge them.

When presenting your science project think about and let us know:

- What did you explore?
- Why did you choose this project?
- What went well?
- What did you find out?
- Would you change anything next time?

All children who enter will receive an Ogden Trust Badge and then winners will be chosen from each key stage for some prizes. This year British Science Week is all about **'Connections'** so let's become scientists, explore, research and experiment. I look forward to seeing your projects which I will display during British Science Week for all to see.
