Re: River Trip – Thursday 6th July 2023

Our topic this half term will be Rivers. In order to consolidate their knowledge and to end the topic, we have arranged for the Year 3 children go on a river walk at the Wolseley Centre with the Staffordshire Wildlife Trust on **Thursday 6th July**. We will be taking part in two activities throughout the time we are there.

We will leave school at approximately 9:15 and will arrive back for the end of the school day. Please let us know if your child suffers from travel sickness.
