We have been enjoying our dance lessons based on 'The Great Fire of London' and now we are using harvest as our dance theme.




We've also had great fun making George's Marvellous Medicine with Mrs Wright in Forest School.

We then presented our data in a bar chart. We will repeat this at different times throughout the year to monitor how the plant life changes over time.


