We enjoy Forest School every week and have been learning about the season of Autumn.

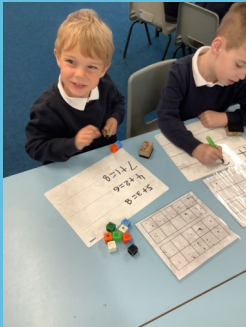
On our scavenger hunts we found fungi, conkers, squirrels and lots of different coloured leaves!

We have been enjoying our dance lessons based on 'The Great Fire of London' and now we are using harvest as our dance theme.

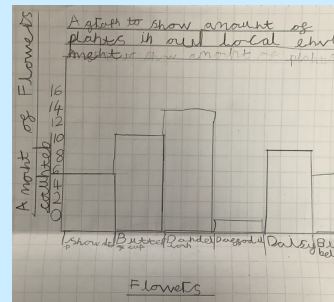


We've also had great fun making George's Marvellous Medicine with Mrs Wright in Forest School.

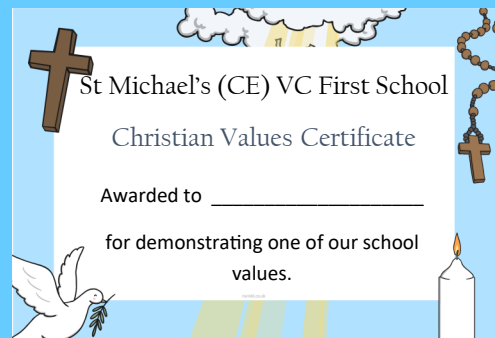
