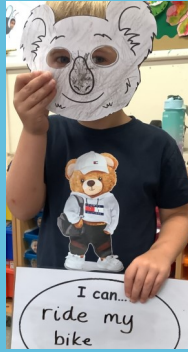

We have enjoyed painting flags, looking at London landmarks and making junk model red buses! Next week will be a new adventure!



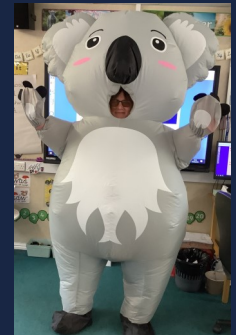
Year 1

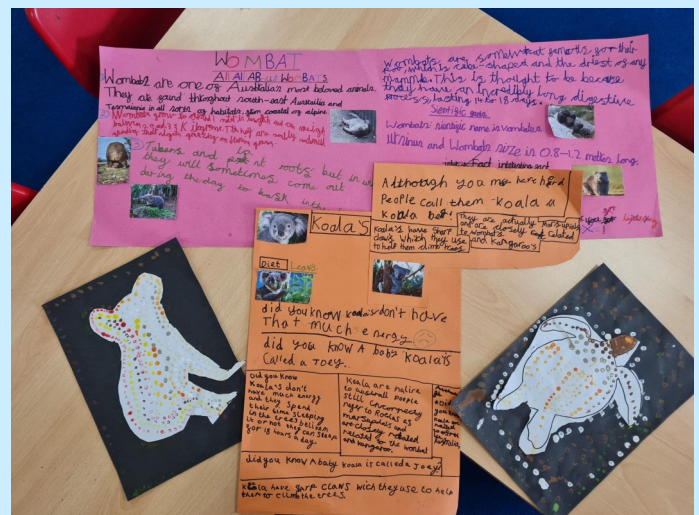
Year 2
