We are learning about different

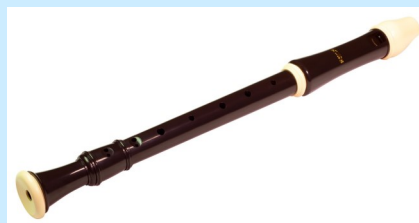
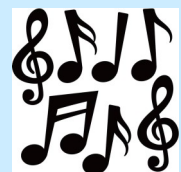
animals and what they need to survive.
