Year 1 and 2



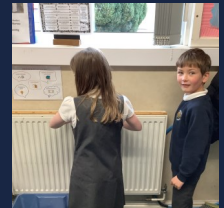
Year 1 and 2 had great fun in PE pretending to do pancake races.
