### Nursery

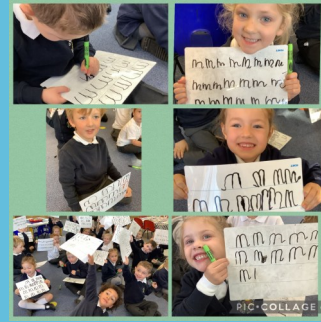
