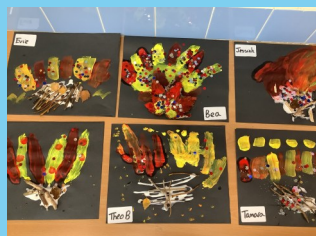
Early Years

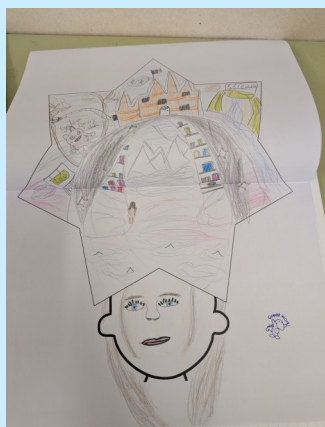


Year 2
