






Our EYFS Curriculum Map - Spring 1

Through God, We Love, Laugh and Learn.

<p>Not all Superhero's Fly!</p>   	<p>Communication and Language</p> <p>We will develop our skills by meeting visitors such as the Police and Doctors, asking questions and listening to them, learning about their superhero jobs. We will develop language linked to people who help us and use this in our everyday playing and learning e.g. role play, hot seating. We will also explore non-fiction texts and learn new vocabulary linked to equipment our secret superheroes need.</p>	<p>PSED</p> <p>We will continue to build respectful relationships with others and making new friends.</p> <p>We will identify people who can help us when we are in need and discuss feelings when thinking about emergencies, social situations and trying something new.</p> <p>We will focus on 'Managing Self' and the importance of being healthy with good hygiene through exploration of oral health, healthy eating and good physical exercise.</p>	<p>Physical Development</p> <p>Indoor PE - We will focus on ball skills in our DEMS programme and begin gymnastics which will continue into Spring 2. The children will learn and practice balances, rolls and safe jumping.</p> <p>Outdoor PE - We will take our ball skills outside exploring bats and balls and throwing and catching. Please ensure your child is dressed for the colder weather for outdoor PE.</p>
<p>Literacy</p> <p>We will begin phase 3 little wandle phonics learning digraphs and trigraphs. We will apply this to our reading practice sessions, writing captions and words containing digraphs and trigraphs.</p> <p>The children will then progress onto longer words, segmenting and blending and learning how to chunk.</p> <p>We will explore non-fiction texts about different careers as well as fiction stories to support our topic such as Supertato and The Jolly Postman.</p> <p>Family café - phonics focus. We will hold a café this half term to support phonics and reading at home. Date TBC.</p>	<p>Mathematics</p> <p>Our Mastery Maths will practice and explore;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • subitising numbers 1-6 • counting and ordinality of numbers and introducing language such as first, second, last • the composition of numbers focusing on 6 & 7, comparing sets thinking about more than/fewer than <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ordering numbers <p>In Shape Space and Measure we will explore mass and capacity developing language of full, empty, heavier, lighter and introduce the use of balance scales.</p>	<p>Understanding the World</p> <p>Our exploration will teach us about Chinese New Year, exploring different faiths and traditions.</p> <p>In RE we will focus on Baptisms and Christenings, sharing photographs and inviting the local Reverend in to hear about a ceremony.</p> <p>In our Outdoor learning and Forest School we will explore ice/snow and changes in seasons. We will develop skills in winter survival for our animals.</p> <p>We will explore maps looking at our local environment and create our own maps, looking at common symbols and landmarks.</p>	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>Our skills will develop through junk modelling and DT in this topic. We will be using our creative skills to design, make and evaluate models linked to people who help us. The children will explore materials, how to use tools safely and the best methods to attach different materials e.g tape, glue.</p> <p>We will develop our pencil skills through self-portraits, learning out our features.</p> <p>Our role play areas will also be changing to different occupations supporting our language development.</p>
