As part of our Topic we have been enjoying creating large sea animals using stones.

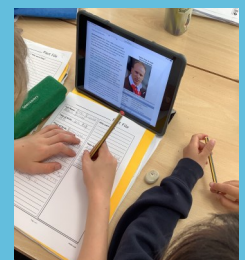
Years 3 and 4
