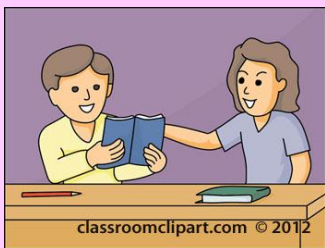

Example of expectations in reading:

- Read accurately by blending sounds in unfamiliar words.
- Read aloud, building and developing phonic knowledge.
- Read common exception words; e.g. could, many, people
- Predict what will happen next.
- Understand they the text makes sense to them.
- Discuss significant events in a text.

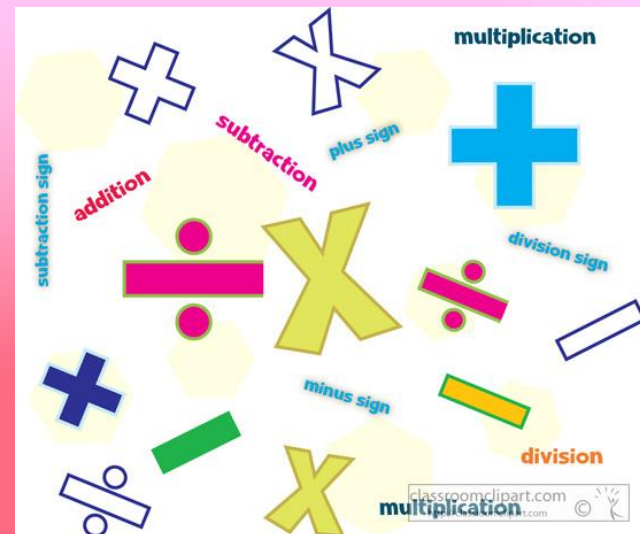
Writing

- Form lower case and upper case letters.
- Sequence ideas and sentence to form short narratives.
- Re read sentences to check that they make sense.
- Spell words corresponding with their phase of letters and sounds.
- Name the letters of the alphabet in order.
- Use capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.
- Write dictated sentences from memory.

- Understand the terms; more than/ less than/equal to/ most/ least.
- Read and write numbers 1 – 20 in words.
- Number bond and +/- to 20.
- To find $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of shapes and numbers
